SUBJECT

The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (Department) is seeking the Board's approval and execution of Amendment Number 18 (Amendment) to Agreement Number 71792 (Agreement) with Norman L. Fogel (Contractor). The Amendment will extend the term of the current Agreement for a period of two years plus three one-year term extension options to allow for continued consulting and technical support services. The current Agreement with the Contractor will expire on September 30, 2014. This extension period will enable the Department to transition smoothly from the existing Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) subsystem to a replacement CAD subsystem. The Amendment will engage Contractor to assist in the testing of the interface between the Department's Console Switching System (CSS) and CAD. In addition, Contractor's hourly rate will increase from \$100 to \$125.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

1. Approve and instruct the Chair of the Board to execute the attached Sole Source Amendment to allow Contractor to continue providing consulting and technical support services (Services) for the Department's CAD subsystem of the Mobile Digital Communications System (MDCS). The proposed Amendment extends the Agreement for a period of two (2) years, from October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2016, and thereafter provides for an option to extend the term of the Agreement for three (3) additional one-year periods, for a total amendment cost not to exceed \$600,000.
2. Delegate authority to the Sheriff or his designee to: (1) execute Change Notices and Amendments to the Agreement as set forth throughout the Agreement and with prior notice to the CIO.; (2) modify the Agreement to include new or revised standard County contract provisions adopted by the Board as required from time to time, including all applicable documents; and (3) execute any of the extension options above, with prior notice to the Chief Information Officer (CIO).
3. Approve an increase to the Contractor's hourly rate from \$100 to \$125, effective upon execution of the Amendment.

PURPOSE /JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approval of this action will allow the Contractor to continue providing Services for the CAD subsystem of the MDCS, and assist with the testing of the interface between the Department's CSS and CAD. The MDCS functions as the command and control communication system for the Department's field operations.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The services provided under this Agreement support the County's Strategic Plan; Goal 1, Service Excellence; and Goal 8, Public Safety by ensuring the continued operation of the MDCS, which is the command and control communication system used by the Department.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The Department has identified funding in its Fiscal Year 2014-15 operating budget for this Amendment. Effective October 1, 2014, the maximum annual contract sum shall not exceed \$120,000 (\$125 per hour * 960 maximum hours). The Department will continue to allocate the funds required to continue these Services throughout the term of the Agreement. The maximum contract sum for this Amendment only, including all extensions, shall not exceed \$600,000. This Amendment increases the Contractor's all-

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inclusive hourly rate for Services from \$100 per hour to \$125 per hour, effective October 1, 2014. The Contractor has not had an increase in the hourly rate of compensation since 2008.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The MDCS is a computer-aided dispatch system that interfaces with vehicular-based mobile data terminals, the 65 channel UHF radio system, the emergency 9-1-1 telephone system, and with State and County law enforcement databases. The hardware configuration consists of a central host computer network using legacy Hewlett Packard hardware connected with 22 Department station computers located throughout the County of Los Angeles. The system is unique and custom designed to meet the Department's specific requirements.

CONTRACTING PROCESS

Contractor has been providing Services for the Department since 1998, through an Agreement executed by the Board on September 29, 1998. Contractor has continued to provide Services for the Department's CAD, initially as an employee of PRC, then as a Contractor to the Department. The Contractor's skill-set, knowledge, and years of supporting the Department's CAD, along with his consistent activities as a programmer, make him the best qualified and most capable contractor to provide the Services required to keep the current CAD operational.

Currently, the Department does not have personnel with the required knowledge base, programming skills and training to provide and maintain the Services required, due to the overall complexity of the software, and the numerous interfaces associated with the Department's legacy CAD. Due to the complexity and now arcane language of CAD, and the significant learning curve to fully support and maintain the CAD, it is in the best interest of the Department and the Los Angeles County to continue Services with Contractor. The Contractor's current Agreement expires on September 30, 2014.

County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

The Chief Information Officer has reviewed and approved the Amendment.

Except as expressly provided in Amendment Number 18, all other provisions and conditions of the Agreement will remain the same and in full force and effect.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES

Approval of these actions will ensure the continued operation of the Department's communications dispatch system to enable field operations to perform legally mandated

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responsibilities.

SUBJECT

The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (Department) is requesting approval of a Sole Source Agreement (Agreement) with DataWorks Plus, LLC (DataWorks) for the provision of maintenance and support services for the DataWorks proprietary software and hardware relating to the DataWorks' Digital Imaging System (System), known as Los Angeles PhotoManager (LAPH), which is deemed necessary by the Los Angeles County Regional Identification System (LACRIS). LACRIS manages the County-wide network of criminal livescan fingerprint devices, the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS), and other systems, which interface with the DataWorks System. The System captures, stores, archives, and retrieves mug shot photographs of all subjects criminally booked within Los Angeles County (County). The System also captures photographs of scars, marks, and tattoos. It also has state of the art software that provides facial and tattoo recognition.

Data works was selected through the Los Angeles County Internal Services Department (ISD) competitive bid process (RFP-IS-1015), In 2008.

The DataWorks System (a more advanced digital imaging mug shot system for LACRIS) was purchased at a cost of more than \$2 million. A Master Agreement (MA-IS-43786) and purchase order (DPO-SH-36506680) were issued for this purchase in addition to related software licensing, maintenance and support. This purchase order expires October 7, 2014.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

1. Approve and instruct the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Agreement for DataWorks Maintenance and Support Services with DataWorks for the period from October 8, 2014, through October 7, 2018, with an option to extend for three additional one-year periods for a maximum term not to exceed seven years with a Maximum Contract Sum not to exceed \$2,180,759.
2. Delegate authority to the Sheriff or his designee to execute Change Orders and Amendments to the Agreement as set forth throughout the Agreement, including: (1) approve assignment of the Agreement to a new contracting entity upon determining that such assignment is in the best interest of the County and execute applicable documents when the original contracting entity has merged, been purchased, or otherwise changed; (2) modify the Agreement to include new or revised standard County of Los Angeles (County) contract provisions adopted by the Board as required from time to time, including all applicable documents; (3) execute any of the extension options if it is in the best interest of the County; (4) delete or add equipment, provided such change does not increase the Maximum Contract Sum; and (5) increase the Maximum Contract Sum by a total not to exceed ten percent during the Term of the Agreement due to an increase in required maintenance and support services due to the addition of new equipment.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approval of the recommended action will allow the Department to continue to receive maintenance and support services for the Department's System. Preventive maintenance, support, and the servicing of the proprietary System must be performed by DataWorks. The services are critical to the operational integrity of LACRIS.

DataWorks is the sole provider of maintenance and support services for all Systems. DataWorks does not contract with, authorize, or otherwise certify any third party to provide support and maintenance to their proprietary System.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The services provided under the Agreement support the County's Strategic Plan, Goal 1, Operational Effectiveness, by allowing LACRIS to operate effectively and efficiently and maintain its System.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The Maximum Contract Sum of the proposed Agreement with DataWork is \$2,180,759, which will be funded by AFIS and monitored by the Remote Access (RAN) Board. There is no net County cost. The annual cost of maintenance and support services for the four-year Agreement Term is: \$250,335.29 for the first year, and \$391,403.90 for each of the remaining three years. The annual cost for each of the additional 3 option years is \$252,070.57.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

DataWorks is the sole provider of maintenance and support services for their proprietary System. In 2008, the Department, through ISD's competitive bid process, purchased the System which included software and hardware maintenance and support. This purchase order expires October 7, 2014.

The continued maintenance and support services of the Department's System is critical to the operational integrity of the Department's LACRIS.

On March 25, 2010, the RAN Board gave approval and allocated funding for a Sole Source Agreement with DataWorks.

The Agreement requires the Contractor to be in compliance with all Board and CEO requirements. The Agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel. The Chief Information Officer recommends approval of the Agreement (CIO analysis attached).

CONTRACTING PROCESS

On July 15, 2010, the Department submitted to the Board an Advance Notification of Intent to Enter into Negotiations for a Sole Source Agreement with DataWorks. The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) approved the Sole Source Checklist on July 27, 2010.

On March 14, 2012, the Department submitted to the Board a Notice Regarding Advance Notification of Intent to Enter into Sole Source Negotiations with DataWorks.

The proposed Agreement with DataWorks was procured on a sole source basis since the System is proprietary to DataWorks.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

Approval of the Agreement will allow the Department to continue to receive uninterrupted maintenance and support services of its System for the Department's LACRIS.

**COUNTYWIDE CLASSIFICATION ACTIONS
TO IMPLEMENT THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 FINAL BUDGET
(ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS - 3 VOTES)**

SUBJECT

This letter and accompanying ordinance will update the County Classification Plan and departmental staffing provisions by deleting one (1) non-represented classification, by reflecting name changes for the Department of Coroner and a division in the Department of Health Services, and by implementing classification actions countywide in conjunction with the Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-2015 Final Budget as recommended by the Chief Executive Office.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

Approve the accompanying ordinance amending Title 6, Salaries, of the County Code to delete one (1) non-represented classification, to reflect name changes for the Department of Coroner and a division in the Department of Health Services, and to update the departmental provisions to reflect positions allocated, deleted and transferred in the FY 2014-2015 Final Budget.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION FOR RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

The majority of actions recommended in this letter are budget related, and were approved - in concept - by the Board of Supervisors (Board) as part of the FY 2014-2015 Final Budget on June 23, 2014. Since that time, we have been working to gather and analyze the required information to determine and allocate the appropriate classification and level of new positions. This letter implements these specific changes to the departmental staffing provisions.

The Board's approval of this ordinance will fulfill the Charter requirement to provide, by ordinance, for the number of County employees. It will also provide the authority for County departments to fill new positions allocated in the FY 2014-2015 Final Budget, delete positions no longer needed, and make other adjustments as necessary. These recommendations are a routine part of the annual budget process.

Deleted Classification

In conjunction with our continuing goal of reducing classifications, we are recommending the deletion of one (1) non-represented classification (Attachment A). This recommendation is consistent with the County's strategy to reduce the number of obsolete classifications.

Department of Coroner Name Change

We are amending County Code Section 6.52.010 to reflect the name change for the Department of Coroner to the Department of Medical Examiner-Coroner, which was approved by the Board of Supervisors at the meeting of September 3, 2013.

Health Services Division Name Change

We are amending County Code Section 6.78.030 (Department of Health Services – Office of managed care) to reflect the division name change within the Department of Health Services. The Office of Managed Care is being renamed to Managed Care Services (MCS) Division. This change is in response to the health care delivery changes required by the California 1115 Medicaid Waiver and the implementation of the Affordable Care Act (ACA). In addition, the reclassification study to provide the appropriate position allocation and organizational structure to assist the department with recruitment efforts was approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 5, 2013. The new name will denote the various changes that the department has undertaken to prepare for the ACA.

Technical Adjustments and Corrections

In addition to classification actions directly related to the FY 2014-2015 approved budget, other technical and routine adjustments and corrections are being made to the staffing provisions of various County departments to reflect earlier Board-approved budget and classification actions. These adjustments include adjusting entries from previous classification actions such as classification studies, reorganizations, and mid-year allocations.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

Your approval of the accompanying ordinance is consistent with the County Strategic Plan Goal 1 - Operational Effectiveness/Fiscal Sustainability as it establishes effective organizational structures and individual position allocations for County departments, which in turn, helps to maximize the effectiveness of processes, structure, operations, and strong fiscal management to support timely delivery of customer-oriented and efficient public services. Specifically, it will improve the quality of the workforce, achieve departmental operational efficiencies, and maintain consistency in personnel practices throughout the County.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The cost of and financing for the new position recommendations have been included in the FY 2014-2015 Final Budget.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The County Charter authorizes the establishment and maintenance of “a classification plan and the classification of all positions.” This responsibility is further delineated in Civil Service Rule 5.

The accompanying ordinance implementing amendments to Title 6, Salaries, of the County Code has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

Your approval of these recommendations will enable departments to effect personnel actions associated with the recently approved budget for FY 2014-2015 and various

SUBJECT

This letter recommends amending agreement with FilmL.A. to exercise an optional five-year extension to continue film and still photography permitting services, and add a provision to designate a County Project Manager for Film Permit Issuance.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

1. Execute Amendment Number One to Agreement No. 77080 for Film and Still Photography Permitting Services with FilmL.A., effective upon Board approval, to extend the initial term of the Agreement for the First Extended Term of five (5) years from September 22, 2014, through September 21, 2019, and modify the terms of the Agreement to designate a County Manager for Film Permit Issuance.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

This purpose of this recommendation action is to 1) continue the Agreement with FilmL.A. to provide the County with Film and Still Photography Permitting Services, as approved by the Board on September 22, 2009, and 2) enhance the County's administration and oversight of film and still photography activity within the County by amending the Agreement to designate a County Manager for Film Permit Issuance to assist the current designated County Project manager.

The Agreement with FilmL.A. is set to expire on September 21, 2014, and execution of the first option extends the Agreement to September 21, 2019.

FOR FILM AND STILL PHOTOGRAPHY PERMITTING SERVICES**

THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO AGREEMENT NUMBER 77080 (hereinafter, "Agreement") is entered into by and between the COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, a body corporate and politic (hereinafter "County") and FILM L.A., INC. (hereinafter "Contractor"), effective upon execution by the County Board of Supervisors.

A. WHEREAS, the County and Contractor entered into Agreement for Film and Still Photography Permitting Services on September 22, 2009 ("Agreement") for an initial term of five (5) years with two optional five year extensions; and

B. WHEREAS, the Agreement currently expires on September 21, 2014; and

C. WHEREAS, the Agreement currently provides the County the sole option to extend the term for up to two (2) five (5) year additional periods, for a maximum total term of fifteen (15) years; and

D. WHEREAS, the County seeks to exercise its first option to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional five (5) years from September 22, 2014 through and including September 21, 2019; and

E. WHEREAS, the County and Contractor seek to modify the Contract in order to change the County Project Manager and to designate a County Project Manager for Film Permit Issuance by adding Section 6.3 and modifying Exhibit E – County's Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, and for good and valuable consideration, the County and Contractor agrees as follows:

FIRST: Paragraph 4.0 (Term) is amended to add the following:

4.1.1 FIRST EXTENDED TERM. The initial term of the Agreement is extended an additional five (5) years from September 22, 2014 through and including September 21, 2019, commencing upon execution by County's Board of Supervisors, unless sooner terminated or extended, in whole or in part, as provided in this Agreement.

SECOND: Paragraph 6.3 of the Agreement is amended to add the following:

6.3 COUNTY PROJECT MANAGER FOR FILM PERMIT ISSUANCE

Prior to release of a permit by Film LA to any film permit applicant, Film LA shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the County Project Manager for Film Permit Issuance that all required approvals for each film location under County jurisdiction have been obtained. Upon receipt of written approval from the County Project Manager for Film Permit Issuance, Film LA shall release the permit.

The County Project Manager for Film Permit Issuance is not authorized to make any changes in any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement and is not authorized to further obligate the County in any respect whatsoever.

THIRD: The Contract's Exhibit E – County Administration – shall be replaced with Exhibit E.1 as reflected in Attachment A to this Amendment Number One.

FOURTH: Except as expressly provided in this Amendment Number One, all other change notices, provisions, terms, and conditions will remain the same and in full force and effect.

FIFTH: Contractor represents and warrants that the person executing this Amendment Number One for Contractor is an authorized agent who has actual authority to bind Contractor to each and every item, condition, and obligation of the Amendment and that all requirements of the Contractor have been fulfilled to provide such actual authority.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County of Los Angeles, by order of its Board of Supervisors has caused this Amendment Number One to be executed on its behalf by the Chairman of said Board and attested by the Executive Officer-Clerk of the Board of Supervisors thereof, and Contractor has executed this Amendment Number One, or caused it to be duly executed by its duly authorized officer.
