Final Actions: Dec. 11 Agenda Highlights (Unless otherwise noted, vote was 5-0.)

\$250,000 proposal would fund service/operation costs for programs serving homeless persons with chronic mental illness at two newly renovated housing facilities in Norwalk. (Item 1-D)
APPROVED 4-0, WITH YAROSLAVSKY ABSENT

Board approval sought to issue \$10 million and \$7 million in bonds to finance acquisition/rehabilitation of 89-unit and 75-unit rental housing developments in unincorporated area near Whittier and East Los Angeles, respectively. (Item 1-H, 2-H, 22, and 23)
APPROVED 4-0, WITH YAROSLAVSKY ABSENT

\$250,000 proposal would help fund the acquisition of 262-acre property in Glendora known as Bluebird Ranch in effort to maintain open space/wildlife habitat. (Item 1-P) **APPROVED 4-0, WITH YAROSLAVSKY ABSENT**

Revised policy recommended for negotiating city annexations and spheres of influence proposals. (Item 5) **KNABE CONT. TO 1/15/08**

Supervisors asked to implement provisions of Senate Bill 959, which would allow some inmates meeting certain criteria to participate in a home detention program designed to relieve jail overcrowding. (Item 6) **APPROVED**

\$2.8 million proposal would fund refurbishment of Auditor-Controller's offices at the Hall of Administration. (Item 8) **APPROVED**

Board asked to approve appointment of Dean C. Logan as acting registrar-recorder/county clerk at salary of \$175,826, and conduct nationwide executive search for permanent replacement. (Item 9) **APPROVED**

One-year extension requested to continue demonstration project relocating homeless families to permanent housing, due to delays in implementation. (Item 11)
APPROVED

\$310,486 proposal would hire consultant to perform satisfaction surveys of patients discharged from Harbor-UCLA, Oliver View-UCLA, and LAC+USC Medical Centers as part of state/federal requirements. (Item 18) **APPROVED**

Supervisors asked to approve revised \$6.4 million budget for the Dockweiler State Beach Youth Center project, and award construction contract to lowest bidder. (Item 27) **APPROVED**

\$4 million proposal would fund construction of 3-million gallon reservoir to meet the needs of a KB Home housing tract in Antelope Valley, with KB Homes funding the balance of the \$5.2 million project. (Item 30) **APPROVED**

Board approval sought to obtain bids for the seismic retrofitting of Los Angeles River Bridge at Alondra Boulevard in Compton and Paramount at estimated cost of \$320,000 to \$375,000. (Item 38) **APPROVED**

Sheriff asks to accept \$10 million in federal funds to hire 126 new personnel at Mira Loma facility to accommodate additional 400 immigration/customs enforcement prisoners. (Item 43) **APPROVED**

Sheriff proposes donation of obsolete and surplus radio and searchlight equipment from aero bureau to sheriff's department in Oklahoma. (Item 44) **APPROVED**

Status report scheduled on implementation of contingency services plan at King-Harbor Hospital. (Item 54) **RECEIVED AND FILED**

Annual tobacco retail licensing fee of \$235 proposed to establish program to clamp down on businesses selling cigarettes to minors. (Item 55, cont. from 11/27) **APPROVED 3-2, WITH ANTONOVICH AND KNABE OPPOSING**
